Popular artists/idols have called out on groups and organizations conducting this kind of act. Through the analysis, it was found that this fans' cooperative practice crosses (1) nation state and (2) a concept of "labor/leisure". This practice is not only achieved by the digital advancement of streaming apps to play music automatically and versatilely, but it is also supported by the fans' social/cultural capitals.
